CONSENT TO PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING	4

Pursuant to art. 14 of EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR), Frigos Europe S.r.l. states that to establish and conduct the business relations we have with you, we have certain of your data, not obtained directly from you, which by law is classified as personal and therefore, as the Data Controller, we have to provide certain information as to how the data are used:

2. Legal basis and purpose for data processing

Frigos Europe S.r.l. processes the personal data you give us for administrative, accounting, tax and marketing purposes, and to satisfy our contractual obligations and related regulations.

3. Processing method

The data is processed using any operation or compound operations as indicated in art. 4(2) of the Regulation.

The data is processed using manual, computerized and telematic tools with logic and methods that are strictly correlated to the purpose as outlined in the previous paragraph, and always in a manner to guarantee data confidentiality and security.

4. Data source

Our company obtains the personal data directly from the person concerned, or the data are accessible to the public.

5. Data categories

The data our company processes are so-called common personal data, i.e. any information about an identified or identifiable individual, with particular reference to identification data including name, identification number, location, online identification or one or more typical elements of the individual's physical.

6. Refusal to provide the data

Any refusal by the person concerned to provide their data would entail:

- If the data are mandatory by law, the consequences as envisaged in the specific regulations.
- if they are necessary to conclude new contract agreements, it would be impossible to conclude the contracts or provide the services for which it is objectively essential to have the data.
- if the data are optional there are no consequences.

7. Right to revoke consent

In the event processing requires your explicit consent (art. 7 Regulation) you have the right to oppose processing easily and free of charge at any time, for all or part of the data that refer to you for said purposes, for example, excluding the automatic contact methods, and your wish to receive commercial and promotional messages exclusively through traditional contact methods.

8. Data communication

Barring the communications sent to satisfy legal obligations, the personal data subject of our processing could be communicated for the purposes described in paragraph 1 to companies, boards and subjects belonging to our group. In order to protect our credit or to better manage the rights relative to each single commercial agreement, the data could be communicated to credit institutes, credit recovery agencies, professionals and consultants.

9. Data transfer abroad

The personal data can be communicated in Italy or abroad for the purposes described in paragraph 1.

10. Data diffusion

The data subject to our processing could only be diffused for the purposes described in paragraph 1.

12. Processing duration

Frigos S.r.l. will process your personal data for the time strictly needed to achieve the purposes envisaged by the articles of association or as foreseen by the sector guidelines. In all events the processing will not last for more than ten years.

13. Rights of the person concerned

Pursuant to articles 15 to 20 of the Regulation, the person concerned is able to exercise specific rights:

1. Receive confirmation whether their personal data exist or not, even if not yet registered, and receive an intelligible communication of said data.
2. Right to access: receive indication a) of the origin of the personal data, b) the processing purposes and methods, c) the applied logic in the case of electronic processing, d) identification details of the data controller, managers and appointed representative pursuant to art. 3(1) of the Regulation, e) to the subjects and subject categories that the personal data could be communicated to or who could learn of the data in their capacity as appointed representative in the territory, managers or assignees.
3. Right to amend any incorrect personal data without unjustified delay and integrate any incomplete personal data.
4. Right to cancellation (deletion): without unjustified delay if the data are no longer necessary with regards the purposes; if the person concerned has revoked their consent; if the person concerned opposes processing; if the data were processed illegally; if cancellation is necessary to satisfy a legal obligation as envisaged by the EU or the member state the person concerned is part of.
5. Right to limit processing: if the person concerned protests the inaccuracy of the data (just for the time needed for the control); in the case of illegal processing; if the data are necessary for the person concerned for the ascertainment, exercise or defence of a right in any judicial seat; while awaiting the control of the existence of the legitimate interests of the data controller if opposition is made to the processing.
